

## Cullerlie Production Car Autotest 19<sup>th</sup> August 2018

1. The Aberdeen & District Motor Club Limited will organise a **Clubman Production Car Autotest** on Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> August 2018 at Cullerlie Far Park, Echt AB32 6XL. OS Map Reference MR 38/746028. The event will take place on grass.
2. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of the RACMSA Ltd incorporating the provisions of the International Code of the FIA, these supplementary regulations, and any written instruction the organising club may issue.
3. RACMSA Permit No 108415
4. The event is open to all fully paid up members of organising club and the following invited Clubs:-

5. Entrants must produce a valid club membership card of one of the invited clubs.
6. The event is a round of the 2018 ADMC & SDMC Club Championships.
7. The programme of the meeting shall be:-

Paddock Opens	09.30hrs
Scrutineering	10.00hrs
First Car Starts	10.30hrs

**NB: Any competitor not signed in by 1000hrs may be excluded.**

8. The event will consist of 2 classes as follows:-

Class 1	Up to 1400CC
Class 2	1401 to 2000CC

All vehicles will be 2 wheel drive only, 4 wheel drive is not permitted.  
Vehicles with forced induction will be subject to a coefficient of 1.7:1. J5.4.1  
Light commercial vehicles will be permitted at the organiser's discretion.  
All vehicles must compete on normal road pattern tyres.  
Winter, M+S, Gravel, Rally or any other "knobbly" tyre is NOT permitted.  
Cabriolet/Sports Cars must compete with the hood/hardtop fitted.

9. All vehicles must comply with RAC MSA Technical Regulations.
10. The event will take place wholly on private property and vehicles do not require road taxed or MOT.
11. Vehicles may be entered by up to 3 different drivers.
12. Awards will be presented as follows:

First overall

First in class

13. The entry list opens on receipt of these regulations and closes at 22.00hrs on Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> August 2018. The entry fee is £20.00. All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee. Cheques should be made payable to Aberdeen & District Motor Club Ltd.

The maximum entry for the meeting is 30 and the minimum is 10. The minimum for each class is 4. Should either of the above minimum figures not be reached, the organisers have the right to either cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as necessary.

Entry fees will be refunded if event is cancelled. There may be a small refund penalty for payments received via PayPal.

16. Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after the event.
17. Any protests must be lodged as per C5.
18. Details of the tests will be available at signing on.
19. Each driver will have three runs at each test with the best two results to count.
20. Timing will be by hand held watch.
21. The starting signal will be 3, 2, 1, Go.
22. The order of attempting tests will be in class order.
23. Practising will not be allowed.
24. Competitors will be identified by numbers which will be provided by the organisers.
25. Marking and penalties will be as printed in the appropriate section of the RAC MSA General Regulations.
26. Course markers may be less than 1m in height.
27. Anyone practising or travelling at excessive speed out with the specified course will be automatically excluded.
28. A passenger must be carried at all times. Passengers must be a member of one of the invited clubs and must be signed on. Passengers do not need to be included on the entry form and can be changed during the day. The passenger must be aged 12 years or over at least 135cm in height and wear a seat belt . Where the driver does not hold a full RTA licence the passenger must hold one and be experienced in Autotests or Autosolos.
29. Access to the venue is by permission of the landowner, please obey the speed limit signs and be considerate to other users of the farm buildings. We depend on this venue, please do not give the landowner any reason to withdraw his permission.
